SCIENTIFIC AREA

The Science Space has inspired many sensational experiences! To review the concepts of cardiovascular and respiratory systems, the students observed a heart and a bovine lung and identified their main characteristics.

VIRTUAL REALITY

AUGMENTED REALITY
